3.0 Executive Overview

3.1 Introduction

St. Andrews Airport is a not-for-profit, community owned airport facility. The Airport is a Controlled airport in the heart of St. Andrews, MB just seventeen minutes north of the City of Winnipeg and offers an excellent opportunity for locating a new or existing business. St. Andrews Airport is owned by the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews and operated as a separate, independent corporation known as St. Andrews Airport Inc. The Airport opened in 1962 to relieve the Winnipeg International Airport of increased flight training and air traffic.

3.2 Airport Overview / Services

St. Andrews Airport is located 8 kilometers north of the City of Winnipeg, within the

Rural Municipality of St. Andrews. The catchment area of the Airport includes the City of Winnipeg.

The airport's main access by road is via provincial Highway 27 and Aviation Blvd. The Airport encompasses 574 hectares of land and is surrounded by flat farmland and rural residential development.

Immediate proximity to the City of Winnipeg enables St Andrews airport to offer both scheduled and charter air carrier service, in addition to flying training and a comprehensive set of aircraft maintenance and overhaul facilities. St. Andrews Airport accounts for about 22% of all the recorded aircraft movements at certified airports within Manitoba making it the second busiest airport in Manitoba after the Winnipeg International and the 15th busiest in Canada in 2018, out of about 426 certified airports. It is the home of 180 aircraft, 11 aircraft repair / maintenance shops, 3 charter operators, 2 helicopter operators, 2 manufacturers, 2 flying schools and 3 scheduled carriers.

The Airport is key to the provision of services to the North as Manitoba Hydro and Manitoba Telephone Systems (MTS) use charters out of St. Andrews Airport to maintain the hydro and telephone needs of the eastern side of the Province of Manitoba from their Selkirk based facilities. In addition, St. Andrews provides the main scheduled service link to fourteen remote band communities in Manitoba and North Western Ontario.

4.0 New Airside Lot Development Details



4.1 Projected Growth

On April 1, 1999, the Airport was transferred from Transport Canada to the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews. In 1999, there were 42 aircraft hangars. At the end of 2018 there were 74 hangars, an increase of 32 hangars or 76 %. There has been additional growth, as five existing tenants expanded their businesses and other new businesses came to settle at the Airport. In 1999, the total square footage of buildings was 159,260 sq. feet. By the end of 2018, there was 359,612 square feet for an increase of 125%. The Airport remains the second largest economic generator within the Municipality after Mandak Industries.

St. Andrews Airport has had an approved Safety Management System in operation since May 2013.

In light of the significant development over the years and the need for new lots, the St. Andrews Airport started construction of 10 new lots on the south side of the airport in September of 2018. These new lots are now completed and are ready for new tenants.

We have 10.5 acres available for new development!



4.2 New Airside Lot Details:

- New lots available ranging from 0.21 Acres to 10.5 Acres
- New lots have new paved airside access
- New lots have Power, Water and Sewer access
- In some situations, lots can be subdivided for multi tenants
- Attractive airside lot rental rates (Current \$ 0.41 / Sq. Foot)
- At St. Andrews Airport there are no "Vesting Fees" and all new lots are assignable creating significant savings over the long term.
